From May 16 through the fall, we'll have coffee available outside of the hub (and inside once in-person resumes). This gives people a chance to gather, laugh, and connect outside without worrying about disrupting the service. May 16, 23 & 30 we'll have coffee available from 11am-12pm.

We will have our full adult service available to anyone who would like to attend. Kids are welcome to join families, but we won't have any kid's programming yet. We're asking everyone to wear masks for the duration of the service. We don't mind if you need to lower it to get a sip of coffee, but ask while we're not crushing coffee, to keep it on.

JUNE 27: NEIGHBORHOOD KIDS IS BACK!

We're taking extra time to reopen our kid's space to find volunteers and create an outdoor learning area (for grade-schoolers). Our rooms for the grade-schoolers are slightly smaller, so we're creating a safe and fun space for those students to enjoy outside of the Hub.
